In addition to the information included in this practice form, as part of your application you will also need to provide:

- Contact details (including name, address and mobile number).
- Details of any communication or other access requirements that we should be aware of to support your participation in this Programme.
- How much financial support (£500 - £4,000) you are requesting.
- Proposed timescale if you are applying for a project (please allow at least four weeks from being informed of the outcome of your application).
- Proposed costs if you are applying for a project. This does not have to be detailed but it needs to indicate how the money would be allocated.
- A CV detailing your writing career as a playwright to date.
- Whether you will be writing in English, Gaelic, Scots or BSL.
